



Master Scholarship for Chinese Women

Sponsors: IE Foundation.

Region: Asia Pacific.

Country: China.

Application deadline: Unless otherwise stated, applications will be submitted always before the day in which the course starts and preferably as soon as admission to IE chosen program and intake has been received.

Objective: To support Chinese women who wish to advance their career through advanced studies, at the Master level. While these scholarships do apply to MBA programs, they also apply to other specialized master programs at IE. Chinese women are currently seeking to gain an edge, and many of these women are continuing their studies as a way to obtain their professional and personal objectives.

Description: Maximum of **8** scholarships will be granted as follows:

- Three (3) scholarship covering up to **30%** of tuition fees for the Global MBA, International MBA or International Executive MBA.
- Two (2) scholarships covering up to **40%** of tuition fees for the Global Master in Finance or the Master in Finance program.
- Five (5) scholarships of up to **50%** of tuition fees for specialized master programs such as the Master in Digital Marketing, Master in Architectural Management and Design, Master in Biotechnology Management, Master in Global and Environmental Change, and the Master in International Legal Practice.

Requirements:

1. Having been offered definitive admissions towards one of the programs above.
2. The scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other IE Foundation or IE partner sponsored scholarship.

Documentation has to be submitted through the *Financial Aid Online Scholarship Application*. Among other documents, these are required:

1. Essay Application Documents:
 - A general essay, where the candidates must explain why you require assistance from IE Financial Aid.
 - Up to three specific essays indicating the reason why the applicants are the most competitive candidate for the scholarships they are applying for.
2. Three last payslips or copy of the last income declaration from the person paying for the program.
3. Additional supporting documents
