



Ex Post Facto Dual Degree Scholarships

Given admissions requirements for three of our Dual Degree programs, namely the:

- 1) International MBA – **Brown PRIME**¹ (Program in Innovation Management and Entrepreneurship)
- 2) International MBA – **Yale SOM** – Master in Advanced Management
- 3) International MBA – **MIT Sloan**

We have a special policy that exceptionally allows candidates for these three dual degrees to apply for a scholarship after they have begun their International MBA at IE Business School.

How Does the Special Policy Work?

All IE International MBA or Master in Management degree candidates that obtain admissions to the above three programs, who apply for one of these scholarships, and who comply with the below requirements will be considered for a 20% Dual Degree scholarship. Because degree candidates will have already paid their tuition fees in full, should an award be granted, the scholarship will effectively be a return of funds to students by IE.

The funds equivalent of the 20% Ex Post Facto Dual Degree Scholarship will only be returned to students once they have enrolled at the partner institution and paid their tuition fees in full at the other institution. IE Financial Aid and the partner institution will collaborate with Administration departments at both institutions to ensure proper processing of funds.

Requirements to Qualify for the Ex Post Facto Dual Degree Scholarship

While these awards are not guaranteed and each application will be considered independently, the requirements to access one of these grants are:

- 1) Degree candidates who wish to apply for one of these scholarships must have indicated their interest in the relevant Dual Degree program, in the Admissions Application Form. Failure to do so will result in an automatic denial of the scholarship application.
- 2) Only degree candidates that have not already been awarded a scholarship by IE are eligible to apply.
- 3) Only degree candidates who have not yet completed the elective period of the International MBA will be eligible to apply for these scholarships.
- 4) Only degree candidates who have maintained an average of 7 or above will be considered eligible. Strong academic performance at IE is a fundamental component of being considered for one of these scholarships.
